KICKSTART:

An extraordinary program that began in 1992 focuses on building strength and character in children at risk. Beginning with sixth graders in four schools in the Houston-Galveston area, they now have 44 schools in Houston, Galveston and Dallas and serve more than 7,000 kids. They are continuing to build a strong program that has proven to keep kids in school, off drugs, and with a high graduation from high school; higher than their peers. School administrators in which the program is found say that these kids have improved grades, improved behavior, and are staying in school.
