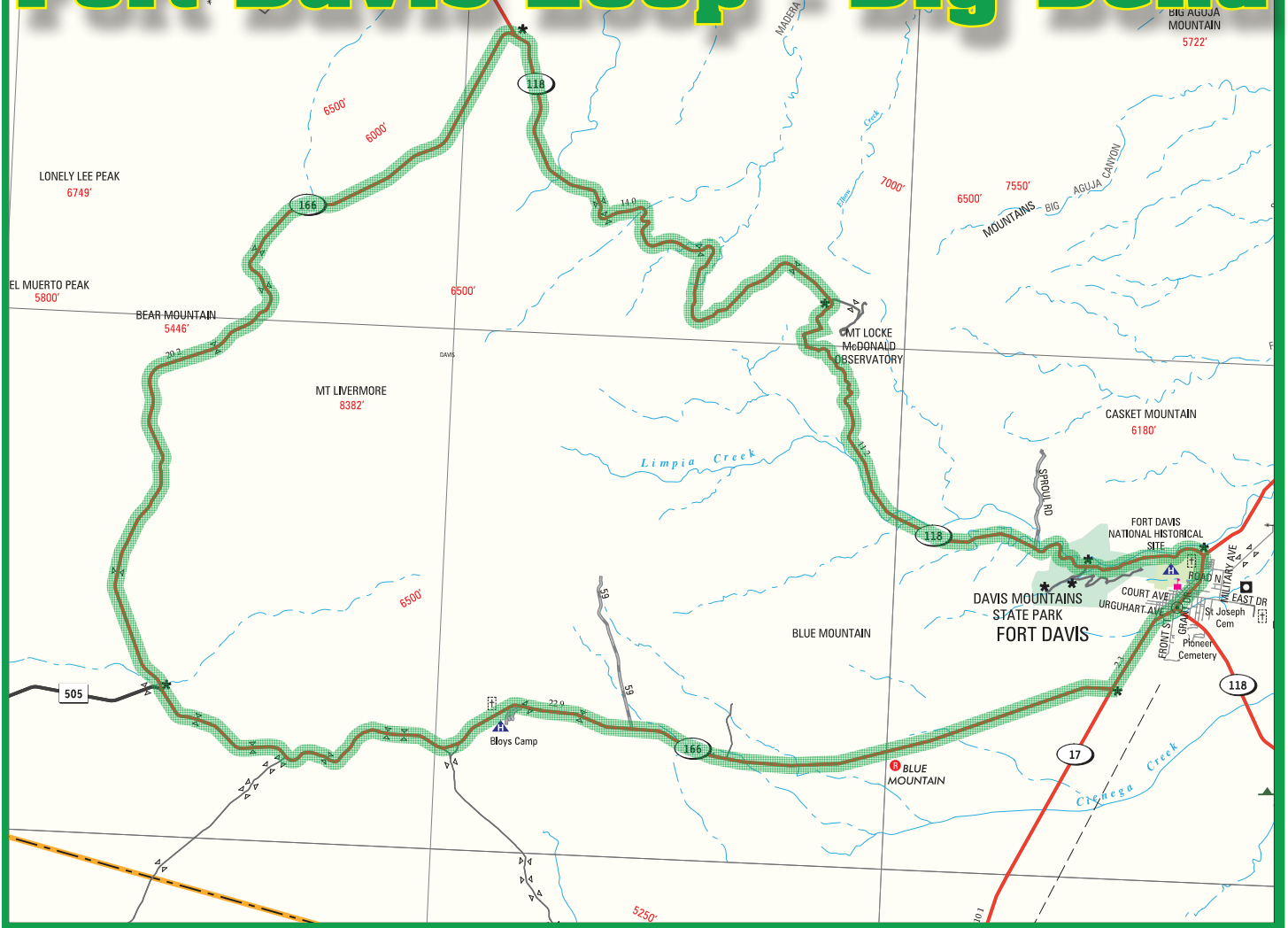


Fort Davis Loop - Big Bend



The Big Bend area of Texas has long been a riders' paradise! Beautiful sweeping and scenic roads delight riders of all levels. As with most of rural Texas, be careful of wildlife; ride during daylight for safety. There are very few gas stations, so gas up when you see one. Along the way, take the OPTION/DETOURS offered.

Take plenty of water and stop often to cool off!

Starting in Fort Davis:

- North on TX118/TX17
- Outside of Fort Davis, stay left on TX118.
- OPTION/DETOUR: Fort Davis National Historic Site, one of the best surviving examples of an Indian Wars' frontier military post in the Southwest. Explore Texas history through more than 20 restored buildings and 100 ruins.
- OPTION/DETOUR: Davis Mountains State Park Road for a beautiful scenic ride with some nice twisties.
- About 30 miles Northeast of Fort Davis, take TX166 (left/Southwest).
- Left on TX17 toward Fort Davis.

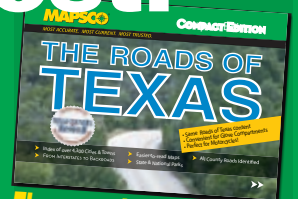
