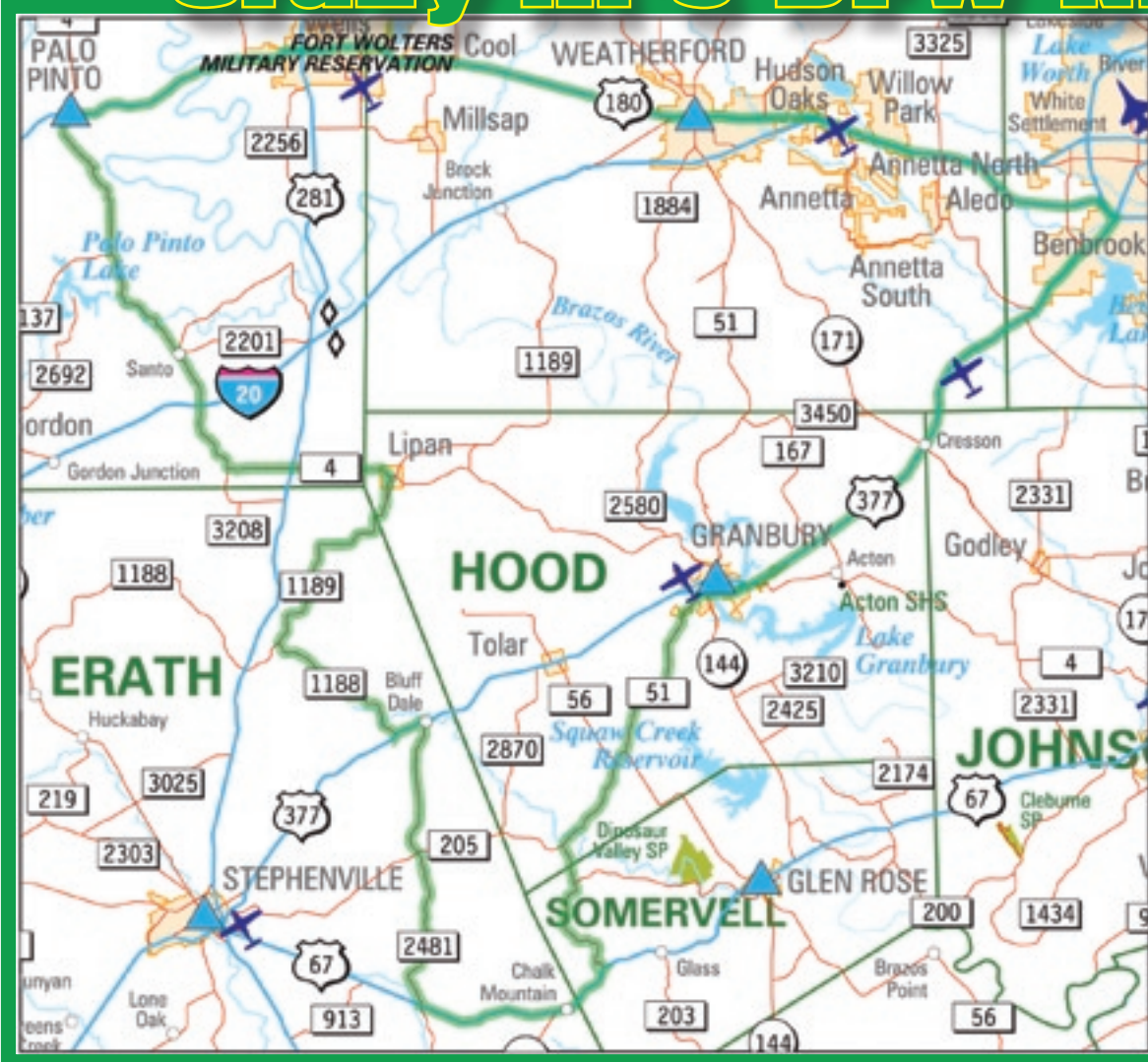


# Crazy AI's DFW Ride



This route is the best collection of tight twisty roads and cool country sweepers you're ever going to find. Enjoy views of the country side that will take your breath away. So hold on to the grips and get ready for the ride of your life!

Start in the southwest corner of Fort Worth at 377 and I-20.

South on 377 till you reach the city of Granbury. You have to exit at 144 and take a right. Go one block and turn left on 51 South. About ten miles down the road the good stuff begins.

Right on Hwy 67, you get the feeling you're in the Hill Country with all the plateaus and rock formations.

Right on 2481 and head North. This is a great sweeper road and be on the look out for the Light House on the Right.

Left on 377 South.

Right on 1188 and go North. This road is smooth and very fast.

Right on 1189 North. Holy cow, keep the Blasters on full. You're not going to believe these two roads.

When you reach the town of Lipan you can gas up and get a snack, maybe dig your underwear out of your butt and get ready for more of the same!

Left on Hwy 4... chill out, shake all the willies off here, it could be your last chance.

Once you pass the little town of Santo it all goes back to rock and roll! You're about to feel like your heading into the mountains.

Right on Hwy 180 and head East. This is a great road with big hills and great views.

Well that's it folks. If you took this route on your own, enjoy the ride. If you run it with me, you might get a patch that says "I SURVIVED 4 AND 51" and you will have earned it!

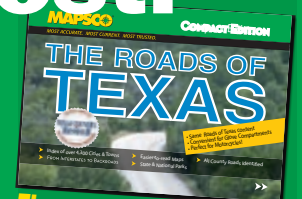
